## How do we light their path? A Word from Our Executive Director



We trust in the one true God, the Christ who was in the beginning and who lights our path. He is purposeful and provides for our needs, even before we realize what we need. It says in Romans 8:28 that "we know ALL things work together for good to those who love God and are called according to His purpose." We love Jesus and want to share that light with those who come through our door every day.

That is what the Lord has called us to do. He's called us to be His light for those who are lost. To light a path to life and to salvation. It's important that we be the light to those facing unplanned pregnancies, those choosing life but are unsure of how to navigate the life they chose, and also for those who were deceived by darkness and chose abortion.

In 2023 alone, over 14,000 abortions were performed in Colorado. 30% of those were from women out of state. 1 out of 5 women have had an abortion, and 1 of 5 of those women attended church regularly. The grief, shame, and guilt that accompanies the choices we make in life are real. **They can only be healed through the light of Jesus.**

So, we ask you to pray! Pray for our staff, clients, and those who harbor that grief of choice whether they be men or women. Regardless of the laws in our state, we have a responsibility to serve all those who need us.

We come together to pray because we believe prayer should be the foundation of all that we do. Having supporters across the northeast plains of Colorado join us demonstrates where our trust is found and how deeply we value the power of prayer in fulfilling our mission. We have already witnessed some amazing stories through these prayers, and we trust that God will continue to move as we grow for the cause of life!

We hope you'll join us January 24-27 at one of our banquets as we "Light Their Path" and share what the Lord has done for us and our clients in 2024. Our banquets allow us to provide financially for our centers as we trust the Lord to intercede on behalf of our centers, our clients, and our communities. **"Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven."** (Matthew 5:16).

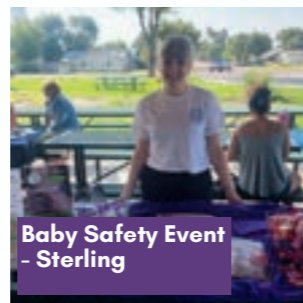

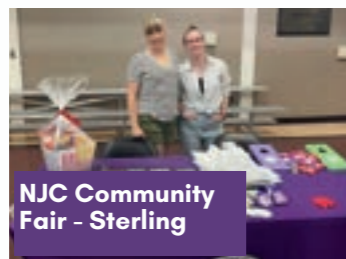

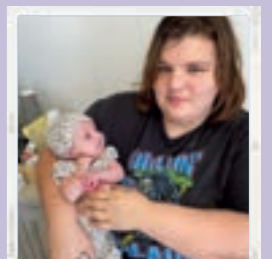
