A Word from Our Executive Director



This fall has been busy with increased client services, community engagement, learning opportunities, and political shenanigans. It has been challenging and rewarding, as we work to provide compassion, hope, and help to individuals facing unplanned pregnancy. The theme impressed upon us at the 2023 National Conferences is to be on a **Pro Abundant Life mission**. We are doing abundantly more as we strive to not only save babies from abortion but also build strong families. Ephesians 3:20 references "...to him who is able to do far more abundantly than all that we ask..." We want to do abundantly more with your support and the guidance of the Lord!

On the political front, the California Attorney General Bonta recently filed a lawsuit against Heartbeat International to censor life-saving information from women regarding Abortion Pill Reversal, despite compelling evidence of the safety of progesterone and its effectiveness in countering the abortion drug, mifepristone. This from the same Attorney General who launched the California Reproductive Rights Task Force (Oct. 2022) with the declaration of "one common goal: to preserve and strengthen reproductive freedoms." And yet, he now is denying California women the reproductive freedom to change their minds by censoring information about Abortion Pill Reversal.

The fight continues across the nation as evil continues to push messages that are confusing and misleading, even to go as far as to say pregnancy centers are misleading and confusing. We knew that the attack would be great once Roe v. Wade was overturned, but you don't know what you don't know! We needed to become educated on ways to combat these attacks while best serving our clients. We were able to send staff and volunteers to Care Net in Mobile, AL, to the Samaritan Summit in Nashville, TN, and to the Rocky Mountain Conference in Colorado Springs. These opportunities have equipped us by expanding our knowledge and our commitment to our mission.

We continue to spread the news of our services through a presence in the community, our updated websites, social media - and it is working! We are seeing more individuals than ever before. We are working abundantly more! It behooves us to remember God's promises, "But those who wait on the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings like eagles, they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint." —Isaiah 4:31 NKJV

Every day we are encouraged to wait upon the Lord so He can renew us and give us strength to tackle whatever comes. The women that come into our centers are searching for strength and hope, and we must be prepared to give it.

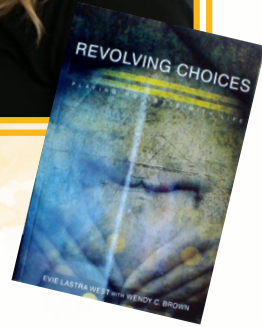
